#### **Attendance**

High levels of attendance at school are crucial for children to make good progress. We are proud to make school attendance a priority here at Ancaster and thank the school community for working with us. The school holiday dates are available for 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 (and beyond) here - <u>School term times – Lincolnshire County Council</u>. Please ensure you avoid school term dates when booking holidays. 5 days off school for a holiday in Term 1 means a child cannot achieve attendance above 85.3% that term. This also means by the end of the entire school year their attendance cannot improve beyond 97%.

Thank you to the staff that have offered to give up time after school to run clubs next half term. We are fortunate that there is such a rich variety of options on offer. You should have now received the forms to complete via ParentHub. Please note, clubs will not take place in the first and last week of term.
