As professionals, working with you to ensure your child has the best possible education, you can be assured that no member of school staff would ever post any comment on social media sites regarding the school, its pupils or parents. We expect that the same courtesy to be shown to each member of staff and would like to reiterate that any issue can be communicated to us face to face or via the appropriate channels. Please be aware that any comments made by parents on social media that is deemed to be considered inappropriate, will result in us contacting each parent directly and asking for these comments to be removed. In line with school policy, we will also report the comments to Lincolnshire County Council and Lincolnshire Police. We hope that in future, we never have to repeat this action and trust that parents will carefully consider any comments made about the school on all social media platforms.
