School responsibilities:

Staff will -

- Ensure that the school is a safe and friendly environment.
- Ensure that children are happy in school and enjoying their education.
- Ensure that each child is a valued member of our school community and is supported to achieve their full potential.
- Inform parents about attendance and remain in regular contact where a child's attendance falls below the levels expected.
- Inform parents of the attainment, effort and progress made in their child's learning via parent/carer meetings and an annual school report.
- Provide an inspiring curriculum for all pupils.
- Achieve high standards of work and behaviour through building good relationships and reward success, effort and achievement.
- Keep parents informed about the daily life of the school via school newsletters, parent hub and termly class newsletters.
- Ensure that the learning environment is safe, clean and well maintained.
- Nurture, care and foster each child to **be the best they can be.**

Pupil responsibilities:

I will -

- Follow the school values and rules.
- Be equipped and ready to learn.
- Complete all work asked of me, including homework.
- Wear appropriate school uniform.
- Remember the only jewellery allowed is a watch and stud earrings.
- Leave toys, electrical items and sweets at home.
- Tell an adult who works in school if I am unhappy or hurt.
- Take good care of other people, the school building and equipment.

Parents/Carers responsibilities:

Parents Will -

- Support the school's Behaviour Policy and model these to their children.
- Uphold the vision and values of the school.
- Ensure their child/ren attend school regularly, aiming to keep attendance levels above 95% (striving for 97+%).
- Ensure that the children arrive at school on time (by 9am) and ready to learn.
- Ensure children are dressed in the correct school uniform, including appropriate footwear.
- Name all of their child's belongings.
- Attend parent/carer meetings and help child/ren meet the targets set.
- Support with any homework set, including regular reading at home.
- Keep your child at home if they are unfit to be at school and inform the school office by 9.15am on **each day of the absence.**
- Communicate with the school regarding anything which may affect your child's education or welfare.
- Ensure that the school always has up to date telephone numbers in case of emergency.
- Notify school of any absences known in advance (E.G. medical appointments) and ensure no holidays are taken during term time.
- Ensure school are kept aware of any updates to a child's medical needs.

To ensure we work together as effectively as possible, supported by our Governing Body, we ask that parents/carers treat all school adults with respect.
