


Home Learning Activity - Literacy

1. Have your own "Elmer Day". Invite your family and dress up in your most colourful clothes! Can you write your own invitations and make a list of everything you will need? What rainbow food will you have at your picnic?
2. Look at the illustrations in the book and think of some speech and thought bubbles for the characters. Are they happy or sad?
3. Decorate the elephants attached. Can you use adjectives to describe them?
