

Home Learning Activity - Maths

Today, we are going to look at measuring units of time. When we talk about how much time has passed, we use seconds (a short amount of time, for example, washing your hands), minutes (a longer amount of time for example, eating a meal, tidying up or reading) and hours (a long amount of time for example, sleeping or going on a walk)

How long do you think a minute is? Ask a grown up to set a minute on their phone. Stand up when you think a minute has passed. How close were you? Have a go at seeing how many of these things you can do in a minute! Can you beat your score? You can play this with your family.

Afterwards, try and complete Miss Leggett's challenges. You can choose as many as you like to complete.




1. Can you make your own veggie superhero? What is their super hero name? Where do they live? Who is their nemesis?

- ⇒ Can you find some other books about superheroes? What happens in the stories? Can you tell me who your favourite superhero is?


Home Learning Activity - Spelling
