


Home Learning Activity - Maths



For this game, you will need a dice.


Roll the dice to see how many pieces of food Greedy Monster will take away. Write how many pieces are left. (Remember to cross off each item as you take it away!)


After you have listened to the poem, have a go at completing Miss Leggett's challenges. You can choose as many as you like to complete.
