Class Morocco Term 3 Curriculum

Within **English** this term we shall be reading our Novel Study 'The Royal Rabbits of London' and using other key texts such as Shackleton's Journey linking to our 'Greatest Explorers' history learning. We shall also be reading 'House for a hermit Crab' by Eric Carle as we learn about texts with recurring language but will also support our science learning about living things in their habitats. In **maths** we shall be looking at number and place value, multiplication and division where the children will learn their 2,5 and 10 times table and the related division facts. We shall also be learning about money, 2d and 3d shapes. **History** is our main subject in focus this term 'Who were the Greatest Explorers?' as the children learn about Ibn Battuta, Captain Cook, Roald Amundsen, Captain Robert Falcon Scott and Sunita Williams and their achievements. **Science** will be continuing our learning about 'Living things in their habitats' as children understand which animals and plants live in a variety of habitats and why, also learning about different food chains. **R.E.** is exploring the value of 'Thankfulness' where the children will learn about festivals giving thanks within Christianity, Judaism and Hinduism. **Art** will be studying the life and work of L.S Lowry as the children develop their drawing techniques within the style of Lowry's famous artwork. **Music** for this term will expose the children to rock music as they listen to different examples and perform and compose their own song becoming a mini rock band! **PE** will focus upon developing the children's sending and receiving skills as we focus upon throwing and catching. Indoor P.E shall take place on a Tuesday and outdoor on a Friday—weather permitting. **PSHE** this term will be covered by Mrs Green on a Monday as the children develop their understanding of financial capability. Mrs Green will also be teaching the children their **Computing** learning in which they will learn to understand and use algorithms.
